

**David L. Treadwell**

David L. Treadwell is chairman, president and CEO of EPMC Holdings Corporation (formerly EP Management Corporation). He joined the company in July 2005 as president of its former Hillsdale Automotive division.

Treadwell led EP Management's predecessor EaglePicher Corporation – a \$600 million diversified holding company – through divestitures of its businesses EP Minerals, LLC, Wolverine Advanced Materials, LLC, EaglePicher Technologies, EaglePicher Medical Power, Hillsdale Automotive, EaglePicher Pharmaceutical and EP Boron.

Treadwell has earned a solid reputation for leading companies through transitions. He previously served as CEO of Oxford Automotive, where he led the \$1 billion Tier 1 automotive supplier through a successful restructuring process.

He began his career with the late Heinz Prechter in his automotive, publishing and real estate groups. Among the positions he held were president and CEO of ASC Incorporated. During his tenure he led ASC through several transitions and oversaw acquisitions and divestitures under the Prechter Holdings umbrella. Upon Prechter's death, Treadwell led the divestiture and wrap-up of Prechter Holdings.

Treadwell currently serves on the board of Flagstar Bank, EPMC Holdco, LLC, C&D Technologies, LLC and FairPoint Communications. He has previously served on the boards of the Wayne County Airport Authority, Flat Rock Metals, ASC Incorporated, Acceptance Insurance Company, Fifth Third Bank-Michigan East Region, Old Kent Bank-Regional Southeast and Oxford Automotive.

Treadwell received his bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Michigan, graduating with high honors.
